Foundations:

Next Level Men (NLM) is an accountability group that is centered in fellowship, spiritual disciplines, and commitment. As with every opportunity that God provides, **what you put in to it will determine what you get out of it -** in keeping with the Biblical tenet "As you sow, so shall you reap." (Galatians 6:7-8)
